MEMBERSHIP DRIVE

- \$10,000 short of overall membership goal; if the goal is met, Ms.Scharfstein will sleep on the roof, live stream and read stories, etc.
- Platinum Incentive (ends 10/1) class with the most Platinum members gets a break during the day with Ms. Scharfstein to hang out & play games.
- Remind SBCE families of corporate matching opportunities to further increase membership dollars to meet our goal.

YEARBOOK

- Half of the goal has been met; 180 sold thus far on track from last year.
- 5th grade cover art contest submissions are due by the end of September & will be voted on as a committee.

GREEN COMMITTEE

- Spirit Nights are an additional way for the PTA & school to earn extra money easily; can get up to a 10% donation of proceeds back to school.

MINI GRANTS

• 33 teacher responses, which will be reviewed by Daphne & Jenelle tomorrow. We hope to be able to accommodate most requests since the budget was increased this year!

SCIENCE FORCE

FALL FESTIVAL

- Farmer's Market booths complete, still working on coordinating games & concessions.
