- * 2 iPads for TAG

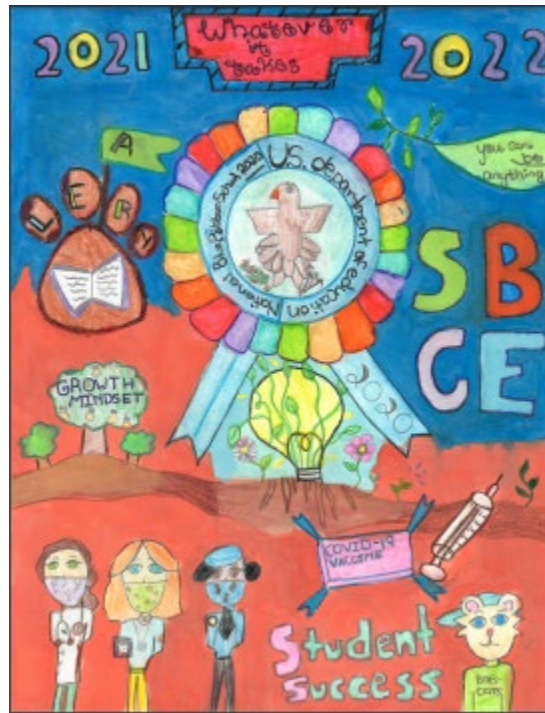
The next round of mini grants will go out in January. We have a total of \$5000 for that semester.
