
Welcome to State Bridge Crossing Elementary School!

Co-Presients

There are two presidents that equally preside over the board and the PTA. These positions include but are not limited to the following duties.

- Work with treasurer to ensure that all financials are in line, yearly budget is planned and managed, and that all vendors and reimbursements are being paid on time.
- Monthly PTA Meetings
- Monthly Administrative meetings to ensure proper support of our faculty and staff.
- Monthly Board Meetings to ensure all committee members are supported.

Treasurer

- Ensures monies are counted by two PTA members.
- Receives funds collected and issues receipts.
- Issues payments to vendors and reimbursements to volunteers.
- Handles deposits and retains deposit slips.

Recording Secretary

- Attends monthly membership and board meetings.
- Recording of meetings.

Parliamentarian

- Provides meeting support to Co-Presidents.
- Reviews and manages Bylaws.

VP of Academics & Fundraising

- Community outreach for partnerships and creation of new fundraising initiatives.
- Gratitude Committee: Send thank you cards to companies, organizations and other donors for their donations to our school.
- Box Tops: Coordinate collection and creation of contests within Box Tops fundraising program.
- Spirit wear: Work with vendor to coordinate the sale of all spirit wear school items.
- Teacher Mini-Grants: Manage applications from the teachers who are applying for mini-grants with the PTA. Lead selection of mini grant recipients.
- Science Force: Coordinate and execute a schedule for hands on science fun that follows the curriculum for each grade. Work closely with the STEM lab teacher and Curriculum Support Teacher throughout the year.
- Read to Succeed: Work with teachers in submitting student reading logs to Six Flags Theme Park for a chance to earn a free ticket to the park.

VP of Communications & School Support

- Family Portraits: Fundraiser offering families professional mini sessions including one edited portrait of their choice.
- Membership Toolkit: Organize an annual membership drive and update the PTA site.
- Yearbook: Oversee the creation and distribution of annual school yearbook.
- Room Rep Coordinator: Guide room parents with coordination of classroom volunteers and activities. Work as a liaison between room parents, teachers, and PTA.
- Landscaping: Coordinate the maintenance of the school grounds during the school year. (Not done by Fulton County).
- Vision & Hearing Screening: Coordinate the volunteers for this day to help with the 3rd grade vision & hearing screening conducted by the school nurses.
- Friday Breakfast: Coordinate the sign-ups & volunteers for the four breakfasts we do for the teachers and staff in our school.

VP of Communications & School Support Cont.

- Teacher Appreciation: Plan and coordinate teacher/staff luncheons throughout the year and organize teacher appreciation week.
- Newcomer's Committee: Welcome breakfast for new families.
- Community Outreach: Social media coordination and website management.

VP of Family Events

- Scholastic Book Fair, held in our media center two times per year.
- Fall Festival: Organization and coordination of our fall family festival, one of the most popular events at SBCE.
- Bingo Night: Organization and coordination of our schools Bingo Night held in the cafeteria.
- All Pro Dads: Breakfast & activity for our dads and their children. Held 4-5 times a year.
- Field Day: Work with the PE teachers in coordinating volunteers and managing the time for this fun school wide event.
- 5th Grade Finale: Organize a committee of 5th Grade Parents and lead the party and planning committee for the 5th grade student's year end events.
- Daughters Choice Dance A wonderful night for our SBCE girls to bring an adult of their choice for a night of celebration and dancing, held at SBCE.
- Son plus one is a day of fun activities for SBCE boys and an adult of their choice. Activities are held on the weekends and vary by year.
